Remember the type of firearm's permit in Massachusetts depends both on a person's age and the issuing authority's preference. The course is 4-hours long and your course instructor is Eric Goodchild, who is NRA-certified to teach this course as well as teaching the "NRA Basic Rifle and Pistol" course.
